Features

- Airen is a productive, vigorous and rather rustic variety, with a drooping bearing. When planted in low density, Airen puts up well with hot and dry summers, even in poor soils.
- Susceptibility to diseases and pests
- Airen is sensitive to grey rot.

Technological potential

- Airen's bunches are large in size, winged, up to 1kg, and rather loose.
- The berries are large, with a simple flavor, a moderately thick or thick skin and a juicy pulp. In its region of origin.
- Airen wines are not very acidic, slightly aromatic, rather alcoholic and sensitive to oxidation.
- They are not very suitable for ageing and should be consumed quickly.
- Airen can also be blended to produce red wines or be distilled to give brandy.
