Table grape variety originally comes from Spain. Clusters are moderately compact and average size. The berries are large, simple flavor with thick skins and not very juicy pulp. Grapes hold up well on the stock and have good capacity for long distance transport.

- This variety is prone to shot berries and must be trained and can be managed with short or long pruning.
- Aledo B is slightly susceptible to grey rot.
