

# FLAME SEEDLESS

## Clone 6011

Table grape variety. Was obtained in 1961 at the USDA Station of Fresno in California. Flame Seedless bunches are medium in size and loose. The fruits have a nice gustatory quality.

### Features

- Flame Seedless has a high vigor, long shoots and a horizontal bearing, that require a sufficient trellising.
- This variety is early and is usually pruned long.
- Flame Seedless is not very sensitive to rot.

- Flame Seedless bunches are medium in size and loose.
- The red or red-purplish berries are seedless, small to medium, simple-flavored, with a lot of bloom, a rather thin skin and a firm and crunchy pulp.
- The fruits have a nice gustatory quality.
