This variety is of Spanish origin and where it is called Graciano. The grape clusters are moderate to large and the berries are small. Morrastel produces tannic, slightly astringent, full-bodied and well colored wines.

Features

- This variety with a semi-erect to erect bearing is well suited for limestone soils, hillsides terroirs and drought conditions.
- It can be pruned in gobelet.
- Given its long growing cycle, it must be planted in sufficiently warm areas.
- Morrastel is sensitive to vine leafhoppers and sometimes to grey rot.

Technological potential

- The grape clusters are moderate to large and the berries are small.
- Morrastel produces tannic, slightly astringent, full-bodied (peppery flavor) and well colored wines.
- The sugar accumulation potential for this variety remains nevertheless low or moderate.
