Table grape variety. Grape clusters are large, winged and moderately compact. Grape maturity: period II. Requires very favorable light and temperature conditions.

Features

- Sultanine B is an extremely vigorous vine variety and grows semi-erect to horizontal and must be trellised and long pruned.
- To obtain good conditions to flower, Sultanine B requires very favorable light and temperature conditions.
- As such, in France, there is generally an absence or just very slight fertility.
- Sultanine B is very sensitive to downy mildew, powdery mildew, anthracnosis, grey rot and phomopsis.

Technological potential

- Grape clusters are large, winged and moderately compact.
- The berries are seedless, moderate in size with a moderately thick skin.
- The pulp is crunchy with a simple flavor, pleasant and not very acidic.
- For the production of table grapes, treatments using gibberellic acid and girdling enable the berry size to increase.
- Sultanine B is likewise the principle variety used for making raisins.
